SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Local Accessory Dwelling Unit Act. Defines terms. Provides that a unit of local government may not prohibit the building or usage of accessory dwelling units in the unit of local government. Provides that a unit of local government may provide reasonable regulations relating to the size and location of accessory dwelling units similar to other accessory structures unless a regulation would have the effect of prohibiting accessory dwelling units. Limits home rule powers.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Local
 Accessory Dwelling Unit Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- "Accessory dwelling unit" means an attached or a detached 8 residential dwelling unit that provides complete independent 9 living facilities for one or more persons and is located on a lot with a proposed or existing primary residence and must 10 include permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, 11 12 and sanitation on the same parcel cooking, as the single-family or multifamily dwelling it is or will be 13 situated. "Accessory dwelling unit" includes, but is not 14 limited to: 15
- 16 (1) An efficiency unit.
- 17 (2) A manufactured home, as that term is defined in 18 paragraph (53) of subsection (a) of Section 9-102 of the 19 Uniform Commercial Code.
- "Efficiency unit" means a unit for occupancy by no more than two persons which has a minimum floor area of 150 square feet and may also have a partial kitchen or bathroom facilities.

- 1 Section 10. Regulation of accessory dwelling units.
- 2 (a) A unit of local government may not prohibit the 3 building or usage of accessory dwelling units in the unit of
- 4 local government.
- 5 (b) A unit of local government may provide reasonable 6 regulations relating to the size and location of accessory 7 dwelling units similar to other accessory structures unless a 8 regulation would have the effect of prohibiting accessory 9 dwelling units.
- Section 15. Home rule. A home rule unit may not regulate accessory dwelling units in a manner inconsistent with this Act. This Act is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised by the State.
