1 AN ACT concerning courts.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Circuit Courts Act is amended by changing
5 Section 4 as follows:

6 (705 ILCS 35/4) (from Ch. 37, par. 72.4)

7 Sec. 4. There shall be no stated terms in the ~~the~~ circuit
8 courts, which shall always be open for the transaction of all
9 business, subject to adjournment from time to time. The
10 circuit judges in each circuit shall prescribe by rule the
11 times of calling grand and petit juries in each of the counties
12 of the circuit and the periods for which the jurors shall
13 serve.
