Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Judicial Vacancies Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (705 ILCS 40/3) (from Ch. 37, par. 72.43)
- 7 Sec. 3. If any provision of this Act or $\underline{\text{the}}$ application
- 8 thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the
- 9 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications
- 10 of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid
- 11 provision or application, and to this end the provisions of
- 12 this Act are severable.
