720 ILCS 5/18-3

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Makes a technical change in a Section defining the offense of vehicular hijacking.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by
5 changing Section 18-3 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/18-3)

7 Sec. 18-3. Vehicular hijacking.

8 (a) A person commits vehicular hijacking when he or she
9 knowingly takes a motor vehicle from the ~~the~~ person or the
10 immediate presence of another by the use of force or by
11 threatening the imminent use of force.

12 (b) Sentence. Vehicular hijacking is a Class 1 felony.
