## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/24-5

from Ch. 38, par. 24-5

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the defacing of identification marks on a firearm.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by changing Section 24-5 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/24-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 24-5)
- 7 Sec. 24-5. Defacing identification marks of firearms.
- 8 (a) Any person who shall knowingly or intentionally
  9 change, alter, remove or obliterate the the name of the
  10 importer's or manufacturer's serial number of any firearm
- 11 commits a Class 2 felony.
- (b) A person who possesses any firearm upon which any such importer's or manufacturer's serial number has been changed,
- 14 altered, removed or obliterated commits a Class 3 felony.
- 15 (c) Nothing in this Section shall prevent a person from
- 16 making repairs, replacement of parts, or other changes to a
- 17 firearm if those repairs, replacement of parts, or changes
- 18 cause the removal of the name of the maker, model, or other
- 19 marks of identification other than the serial number on the
- 20 firearm's frame or receiver.
- 21 (d) A prosecution for a violation of this Section may be
- commenced within 6 years after the commission of the offense.
