A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Quasi-criminal and Misdemeanor Bail Act is
5 amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 195/4) (from Ch. 16, par. 84)

7 Sec. 4. Whenever in any circuit there shall be in force a
8 uniform schedule prescribing the ~~the~~ amounts of fines,
9 penalties, forfeitures and costs on pleas of guilty in
10 specified minor conservation and traffic offenses, any circuit
11 clerk or deputy circuit clerk is authorized to receive written
12 appearances, pleas of guilty and waivers of trial and to
13 accept and receipt for payments, in satisfaction of the
14 judgment to be entered upon the plea, in accordance with the
15 uniform schedule. The accused shall be furnished with an
16 official receipt on a form prescribed by such uniform schedule
17 for the purpose for any fine paid pursuant to this section.
