Amends the Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning legislative findings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 171/3)
- 7 Sec. 3. Legislative finding. The The General Assembly
- 8 finds that a simplified sales tax and use tax system will
- 9 reduce and over time eliminate the burden and cost for all
- 10 vendors to collect this State's sales and use tax. The General
- 11 Assembly further finds that this State should participate in
- 12 multistate discussions to review or amend or both review and
- amend the terms of the Agreement to simplify and modernize
- 14 sales tax and use tax administration in order to substantially
- 15 reduce the burden of tax compliance for all sellers and for all
- 16 types of commerce.
