Amends the Simplified Sales Tax and Use Tax Administration Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning multistate negotiations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration
5 Act is amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 171/4)

7 Sec. 4. Authority to participate in multistate
8 negotiations. For the ~~the~~ purposes of reviewing or amending or
9 both reviewing and amending the Agreement embodying the
10 simplification requirements as contained in Section 7 of this
11 Act, the State shall enter into multistate discussions. For
12 purposes of such discussions, the State shall be represented
13 by 4 delegates. One delegate shall be appointed by the
14 President of the Senate, one by the Minority Leader of the
15 Senate, one by the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
16 and one by the Minority Leader of the House of
17 Representatives.
