1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1574

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1574 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.84 and 34-18.79 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.84 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.84. Halal and kosher food services. Each school
8 board shall provide for a program by which both halal and
9 kosher food options that comply with federal and State
10 nutritional guidelines are offered in public school cafeterias
11 by request. Any halal or kosher food product offered under
12 this Section shall be certified as halal or kosher by a
13 State-approved organization or purchased from a State-approved
14 halal-certified or kosher-certified vendor. Any person,
15 organization, or vendor falsely representing a food product it
16 provides as halal or falsely representing itself as a

1 halal-certified vendor shall be subject to penalty under the
2 Halal Food Act. Any person, organization, or vendor falsely
3 representing a food product it provides as kosher or falsely
4 representing itself as a kosher-certified vendor shall be
5 subject to penalty under the Kosher Food Act. As used in this
6 Section, "halal" has the same meaning as provided under
7 Section 5 of the Halal Food Act. As used in this Section,
8 "kosher" has the meaning provided under orthodox Jewish law.

9 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.79 new)

10 Sec. 34-18.79. Halal and kosher food services. The board
11 shall provide for a program by which halal and kosher food
12 options that comply with federal and State nutritional
13 guidelines are offered in school cafeterias by request. Any
14 halal or kosher food product offered under this Section shall
15 be certified as halal or kosher by a State-approved
16 organization or purchased from a State-approved
17 halal-certified or kosher-certified vendor. Any person,
18 organization, or vendor falsely representing a food product it
19 provides as halal or falsely representing itself as a
20 halal-certified vendor shall be subject to penalty under the
21 Halal Food Act. Any person, organization, or vendor falsely
22 representing a food product it provides as kosher or falsely
23 representing itself as a kosher-certified vendor shall be
24 subject to penalty under the Kosher Food Act. As used in this
25 Section, "halal" has the same meaning as provided under

1 Section 5 of the Halal Food Act. As used in this Section,
2 "kosher" has the meaning provided under orthodox Jewish law.

3 Section 15. The Halal Food Act is amended by adding
4 Section 25 as follows:

5 (410 ILCS 637/25 new)

6 Sec. 25. State facility halal food services.

7 (a) Any State-owned or State-operated facility that
8 provides food services or cafeteria services for which food
9 products are provided or offered for sale also shall offer,
10 upon request provided with reasonable notice, halal food
11 options that comply with federal and State nutritional
12 guidelines at such facility.

13 (b) Any halal food product offered under this Section
14 shall be certified as halal by a State-approved organization
15 or purchased from a State-approved halal-certified vendor. Any
16 person, organization, or vendor falsely representing a food
17 product it provides as halal or falsely representing itself as
18 a halal-certified vendor shall be subject to penalties under
19 Section 10 or 15 of this Act.

20 (c) The Department of Central Management Services and all
21 other relevant State agencies shall adopt all rules necessary
22 for the implementation of this Section.

23 Section 20. The Kosher Food Act is amended by adding

1 Section 1.5 and by changing Section 2 as follows:

2 (410 ILCS 645/1.5 new)

3 Sec. 1.5. State facility kosher food services.

4 (a) As used in this Section, "kosher" has the meaning
5 provided under orthodox Jewish law.

6 (b) Any State-owned or State-operated facility that
7 provides food services or cafeteria services for which food
8 products are provided or offered for sale also shall offer,
9 upon request provided with reasonable notice, kosher food
10 options that comply with federal and State nutritional
11 guidelines at such facility.

12 (c) Any kosher food product offered under this Section
13 shall be certified as kosher by a State-approved organization
14 or purchased from a State-approved kosher-certified vendor.
15 Any person, organization, or vendor falsely representing a
16 food product it provides as kosher or falsely representing
17 itself as a kosher-certified vendor shall be subject to
18 penalties under Section 2 of this Act.

19 (d) The Department of Central Management Services and all
20 other relevant State agencies shall adopt all rules necessary
21 for the implementation of this Section.

23 Sec. 2. Any person convicted of violating Section 1 or 1.5
24 of this Act, shall for the first offense, be guilty of a Class

1 C misdemeanor and for the second and each subsequent offense
2 shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
