Identification cards; suicide prevention information. Each school district that serves pupils in any of 10 grades 6 through 12 and that issues an identification card to 11 pupils in any of grades 6 through 12 shall provide contact 12 information for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline 13 14 (988), the Crisis Text Line, and either the Safe2Help Illinois

- 3 The contact information shall be included in the school's
- 4 student handbook and also the student planner if a student

- 8 Sec. 34-18.67. Identification cards; suicide prevention
