SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/4-14.2 new
10 ILCS 5/5-9.2 new
10 ILCS 5/6-55.5 new

Amends the Election Code. Requires a county clerk or board of election commissioners to cross-check each voter registration roll with the national Change of Address System information gathered by the United States Postal Service to determine if the changed address of each person who has filed a change of address has resulted in the removal of that person from the voting precinct or voting election district in which he or she was enrolled as a voter. Requires the county clerk or board of election commissioners to automatically remove, from each voter registration roll that contains a self-removed person's former address, that person from the voter roll of his or her former precinct or former election district.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Sections
5 4-14.2, 5-9.2, and 6-55.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 4-14.2. Change of address. The county clerk shall
8 cross-check each voter registration roll with the national
9 Change of Address System information gathered by the United
10 States Postal Service to determine if the changed address of
11 each person who has filed a change of address has resulted in
12 the removal of that person from the voting precinct or voting
13 election district in which he or she was enrolled as a voter.
14 The county clerk shall automatically remove, from each voter
15 registration roll that contains a self-removed person's former
16 address, that person from the voter roll of his or her former
17 precinct or former election district.

19 Sec. 5-9.2. Change of address. The county clerk shall
20 cross-check each voter registration roll with the national

22 States Postal Service to determine if the changed address of

14 address has resulted in the removal of that person from the
15 voting precinct or voting election district in which he or she
16 was enrolled as a voter. The board of election commissioners
17 shall automatically remove, from each voter registration roll
18 that contains a self-removed person's former address, that
19 person from the voter roll of his or her former precinct or
20 former election district.
