2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1976, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. "An Act concerning regulation", approved
6 August 24, 2021, Public Act 102-578, is amended by changing
7 Section 99 as follows:

8 (P.A. 102-578, Sec. 99)

9 Sec. 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
10 2022 ~~December 31, 2022~~.

12 Section 10. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
13 changing Section 1655 as follows:

14 (215 ILCS 5/1655)

3 Sec. 1655. Policy.

4 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code,
5 travel insurance shall be classified and filed for purposes of
6 rates and forms under an inland marine line of insurance;
7 however, including travel insurance that provides coverage for
8 sickness, accident, disability, or death occurring during
9 travel, either exclusively, or in conjunction with related
10 coverages of emergency evacuation or repatriation of remains,
11 or incidental limited property and casualty benefits such as
12 baggage or trip cancellation may be filed under either an
13 accident and health line of insurance or an inland marine line
14 of insurance.

15 (b) Travel insurance may be in the form of an individual,
16 group, master, or blanket policy.

17 (c) Eligibility and underwriting standards for travel
18 insurance may be developed and provided based on travel
19 protection plans designed for individual or identified
20 marketing or distribution channels, provided those standards
21 also meet this State's underwriting standards for inland
22 marine.
