Amends the Rivers, Lakes, and Streams Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the jurisdiction of the Department of Natural Resources under the Act.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Rivers, Lakes, and Streams Act is amended by changing Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (615 ILCS 5/5) (from Ch. 19, par. 52)
- Sec. 5. The The Department of Natural Resources shall upon behalf of the State of Illinois, have jurisdiction and 8 9 supervision over all of the rivers and lakes of the State of Illinois, wherein the State of Illinois or the people of the 10 State have any rights or interests, and shall make a list by 11 counties of all the waters of Illinois, showing the waters, 12 13 both navigable and non-navigable, that are found in each 14 county of the State, and if the same are lakes, the extent of the shore lines and the amount, extent and area of the water 15 16 surface; and in a like way, if the same are rivers, and 17 specifying whether the same are navigable or non-navigable, and whether they have or have not been meandered. 18
