## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/18a-302 from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 18a-302

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning relocation services.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 changing Section 18a-302 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/18a-302) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 18a-302)

7 Sec. 18a-302. Owner or other person in lawful possession or control of private property - Right to employ relocation 8 9 service. It shall be unlawful for for an owner or other person in lawful possession or control of private property to remove 10 or employ a commercial relocator to remove an unauthorized 11 vehicle from such property unless written notice is provided 12 to the effect that such vehicles will be removed, including 13 14 the name, address and telephone number of the appropriate commercial vehicle relocator, if any. Such notice shall 15 16 consist of a sign, posted in a conspicuous place in the affected area, of a size at least 24 inches in height by 36 17 inches in width. Such sign shall be at least 4 feet from the 18 19 ground but less than 8 feet from the ground and shall be either illuminated or painted with reflective paint, or both. Such 20 21 sign shall state the amount of towing charges to which the 22 person parking may be subject. This provision shall not be construed as prohibiting any unit of local government from 23

1 imposing additional or greater notice requirements.

No express notice shall be required under this Section upon residential property which, paying due regard to the circumstances and the surrounding area, is clearly reserved or intended exclusively for the use or occupation of residents or their vehicles.
