

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB2383

Introduced 2/17/2021, by Rep. Sonya M. Harper

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-72-5 new 30 ILCS 805/8.45 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a municipality with a population of over 100,000 in the 2020 Federal decennial census shall adopt a tree planting plan that identifies areas of canopy loss and creates a plan for protection or expansion of the tree canopy in the municipality. Provides that the tree planting plan must be adopted and implemented no later than 10 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act and that the implementation of the tree planting plan must be completed no later than 20 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act. Limits home rule powers. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding Section 11-72-5 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-72-5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 11-72-5. Tree planting plan.</u>
- (a) A municipality with a population of over 100,000 in 8 9 the 2020 Federal decennial census shall adopt a tree planting plan that identifies areas of canopy loss and creates a plan 10 for protection or expansion of the tree canopy in the 11 12 municipality. The tree planting plan must be adopted and implemented no later than 10 years after the effective date of 13 14 this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly. The implementation of the tree planting plan must be completed no 15 later than 20 years after the effective date of this 16

amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly.

(b) A home rule municipality with a population of over 100,000 in the 2020 Federal decennial census may not adopt or implement a tree planning plan in a manner inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and
