A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
6 to the Department of Children and Family Services, for grants
7 to the Court Appointed Special Advocates of Cook County to be
8 used to advocate for the timely placement of children in
9 permanent, safe, and stable homes.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
11 2021.
