SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.935 new 625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 625 ILCS 5/3-805 625 ILCS 5/3-636 rep.

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-805

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Repeals a Section authorizing the issuance of Knights of Columbus Special License Plates. Provides instead that the Department of Human Services may issue decals for Universal special license plates. Provides that the cost for the decals shall be \$25 at original issuance and renewal. Provides that \$15 of each original issuance and \$2 of each renewal shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that \$10 of each original issuance and \$2 of each renewal shall be deposited into the Knights of Columbus Fund. Provides that money in the Knights of Columbus Fund shall be paid as grants to charitable entities designated by the Knights of Columbus. Makes a corresponding change in the State Finance Act. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the owner of a motor vehicle of the first division or a motor vehicle of the second division weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric engine and not utilizing motor fuel who qualifies for any veteran license plate offered by the Secretary of State shall pay the same registration fee as that charged for his or her qualifying plate. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
- 13 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
- 14 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
- 15 issue Universal special license plates to residents of
- 16 Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized
- by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special
- 18 license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by
- 19 the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized
- 20 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this
- 21 Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate

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the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record of that organization and that organization shall remain affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered, revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal, sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal special license plate other than a decal authorized by the General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for

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- Universal special license plates shall comply with rules adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and approval of Universal special license plate decals. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary of State must make a version of the special registration plates authorized under this Section in a form appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.
 - (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate, the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged, the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed. When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate. Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act. Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.
 - (d) Upon original issuance and for each registration

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renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration 1 2 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional 3 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the 5 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State 6 7 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into 8 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the 9 organization to issue decals for Universal special license 10 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed 11 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General 12 Assembly.

- (e) The following organizations may issue decals for Universal special license plates with the original and renewal fees and fee distribution as follows:
 - (1) The Illinois Department of Natural Resources.
 - (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.
 - (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.
 - (2) Illinois Veterans' Homes.
- (A) Original issuance: \$26, which shall be deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.
- 26 (B) Renewal: \$26, which shall be deposited into

- (f) The following funds are created as special funds in the State treasury:
 - (1) The Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund. All money in the Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund shall moneys to be paid as grants to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources to fund roadside monarch and other pollinator habitat development, enhancement, and restoration projects in this State.
 - (2) The Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in the Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund shall moneys to be paid as grants to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Chicago.
 - (3) The Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund. All money in the Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund moneys shall be paid as grants to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois.
 - (4) The Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund. All money in the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund shall be paid as grants to K9s for Veterans, NFP for support, education, and awareness of veterans with post-traumatic stress disorder.
 - (5) (4) The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All money in the Guide Dogs of America Fund moneys shall be paid as grants to the International Guiding Eyes, Inc., doing business as Guide Dogs of America.
 - (6) (5) The Mechanics Training Fund. All money in the Mechanics Training Fund moneys shall be paid as grants to

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the Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.

- (7) (4) The Theresa Tracy Trot Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund. All money in the Theresa Tracy Trot Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of furthering pancreatic cancer research.
- (8) (4) The Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund. All money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund shall moneys to be paid as grants to the Illinois Department of Human Services to fund legal aid groups to assist with guardianship fees for private citizens willing to become guardians for individuals with developmental disabilities but who are unable to pay the legal fees associated with becoming a guardian.
- (9) (4) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall moneys to be paid as grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for pediatric cancer treatment and research.
- (10) The Knights of Columbus Fund. All money in the Knights of Columbus Fund shall be paid as grants to charitable entities designated by the Knights of Columbus.

- 2 Sec. 3-805. Electric vehicles.
- 3 (a) Until January 1, 2020, the owner of a motor vehicle of 4 the first division or a motor vehicle of the second division 5 weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric engine 6 and not utilizing motor fuel, may register such vehicle for a fee not to exceed \$35 for a 2-year registration period. The 7 Secretary may, in his discretion, prescribe that electric 8 9 vehicle registration plates be issued for an indefinite term, 10 such term to correspond to the term of registration plates 11 issued generally, as provided in Section 3-414.1. In no event 12 may the registration fee for electric vehicles exceed \$18 per 1.3 registration year. Except as provided in subsection (b), beginning Beginning on January 1, 2020, the registration fee 14 15 for these vehicles shall be equal to the fee set forth in 16 Section 3-806 for motor vehicles of the first division, other than Autocycles, Motorcycles, Motor Driven Cycles, 17 18 Pedalcycles. In addition to the registration fees, the Secretary shall assess an additional \$100 per year in lieu of 19 the payment of motor fuel taxes. \$1 of the additional fees 20 21 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special 22 Services Fund and the remainder of the additional fees shall be deposited into the Road Fund. 23
 - (b) The owner of a motor vehicle of the first division or a motor vehicle of the second division weighing 8,000 pounds or
