#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699.14

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Repeals a Section authorizing the issuance of Knights of Columbus Special License Plates. Provides instead that the Department of Human Services may issue decals for Universal special license plates. Provides that the cost for the decals shall be \$25 at original issuance and renewal. Provides that \$15 of each original issuance and \$2 of each renewal shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that \$10 of each original issuance and \$2 of each renewal shall be deposited into the Knights of Columbus Fund. Provides that money in the Knights of Columbus Fund shall be paid as grants to charitable entities designated by the Knights of Columbus. Makes a corresponding change in the State Finance Act. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the owner of a motor vehicle of the first division or a motor vehicle of the second division weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric engine and not utilizing motor fuel who qualifies for any veteran license plate offered by the Secretary of State shall pay the same registration fee as that charged for his or her qualifying plate. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 5.935 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.935 new)

7 Sec. 5.935. The Knights of Columbus Fund.

8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
9 changing Sections 3-699.14 and 3-805 as follows:

10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14)

11 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the  
13 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and  
14 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may  
15 issue Universal special license plates to residents of  
16 Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized  
17 by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special  
18 license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by  
19 the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized  
20 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this  
21 Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate

1 the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the  
2 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a  
3 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record  
4 of that organization and that organization shall remain  
5 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered,  
6 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization  
7 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and  
8 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the  
9 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct  
10 from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal,  
11 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal  
12 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the  
13 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal  
14 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be  
15 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,  
16 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the  
17 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates  
18 issued under this Section shall expire according to the  
19 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

20 (b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special  
21 license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the  
22 Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required  
23 to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection  
24 (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for  
25 the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations  
26 authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for

1 Universal special license plates shall comply with rules  
2 adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and  
3 approval of Universal special license plate decals. The  
4 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal  
5 special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized  
6 plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The  
7 Secretary of State must make a version of the special  
8 registration plates authorized under this Section in a form  
9 appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.

10 (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate,  
11 the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee  
12 is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged,  
13 the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed.  
14 When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a  
15 special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be  
16 deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate.  
17 Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid  
18 over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in  
19 compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of  
20 the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.  
21 Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal  
22 special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of  
23 State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General  
24 verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable  
25 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.

26 (d) Upon original issuance and for each registration

1 renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration  
2 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional  
3 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license  
4 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the  
5 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the  
6 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State  
7 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into  
8 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the  
9 organization to issue decals for Universal special license  
10 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed  
11 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General  
12 Assembly.

13 (e) The following organizations may issue decals for  
14 Universal special license plates with the original and renewal  
15 fees and fee distribution as follows:

16 (1) The Illinois Department of Natural Resources.

17 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
18 Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$15 to the Secretary  
19 of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Roadside Monarch  
21 Habitat Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special  
22 License Plate Fund.

23 (2) Illinois Veterans' Homes.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$26, which shall be  
25 deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

26 (B) Renewal: \$26, which shall be deposited into

1 the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

2 (3) The Illinois Department of Human Services for  
3 volunteerism decals.

4 (A) Original issuance: \$25, which shall be  
5 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License  
6 Plate Fund.

7 (B) Renewal: \$25, which shall be deposited into  
8 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

9 (4) The Illinois Department of Public Health.

10 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
11 Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the  
12 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

13 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Prostate Cancer  
14 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State  
15 Special License Plate Fund.

16 (5) Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

17 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
18 Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund and \$15 to the  
19 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Horsemen's  
21 Council of Illinois Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of  
22 State Special License Plate Fund.

23 (6) K9s for Veterans, NFP.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
25 Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund and \$15  
26 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

1 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Post-Traumatic  
2 Stress Disorder Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary  
3 of State Special License Plate Fund.

4 (7) ~~(6)~~ The International Association of Machinists  
5 and Aerospace Workers.

6 (A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$20 to the Guide  
7 Dogs of America Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of State  
8 Special License Plate Fund.

9 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 going to the Guide Dogs  
10 of America Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State  
11 Special License Plate Fund.

12 (8) ~~(7)~~ Local Lodge 701 of the International  
13 Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers.

14 (A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$10 to the Guide  
15 Dogs of America Fund, \$10 to the Mechanics Training

18 (B) Renewal: \$30; with \$13 to the Guide Dogs of  
19 America Fund, \$15 to the Mechanics Training Fund, and

11 State Special License Plate Fund.

15 Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the

18 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State  
19 Special License Plate Fund.

23 Knights of Columbus Fund and \$15 to the Secretary of  
24 State Special License Plate Fund.

25 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Knights of  
26 Columbus Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special

2           (f) The following funds are created as special funds in  
3 the State treasury:

4           (1) The Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund. All money in  
5 the Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund shall ~~moneys to~~ be paid  
6 as grants to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources  
7 to fund roadside monarch and other pollinator habitat  
8 development, enhancement, and restoration projects in this  
9 State.

10          (2) The Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in  
11 the Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund shall ~~moneys to~~ be paid  
12 as grants to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Chicago.

13          (3) The Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund. All money  
14 in the Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund ~~moneys~~ shall be  
15 paid as grants to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

16          (4) The Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund.  
17 All money in the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness  
18 Fund shall be paid as grants to K9s for Veterans, NFP for  
19 support, education, and awareness of veterans with  
20 post-traumatic stress disorder.

21          (5) ~~(4)~~ The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All money in  
22 the Guide Dogs of America Fund ~~moneys~~ shall be paid as  
23 grants to the International Guiding Eyes, Inc., doing  
24 business as Guide Dogs of America.

25          (6) ~~(5)~~ The Mechanics Training Fund. All money in the  
26 Mechanics Training Fund ~~moneys~~ shall be paid as grants to

1 the Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.

2 (7) ~~(4)~~ The Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare  
3 Foundation Fund. All money in the Theresa Tracy Trot -  
4 Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the  
5 Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of  
6 furthering pancreatic cancer research.

7 (8) ~~(4)~~ The Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund.  
8 All money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund  
9 shall moneys ~~to~~ be paid as grants to the Illinois  
10 Department of Human Services to fund legal aid groups to  
11 assist with guardianship fees for private citizens willing  
12 to become guardians for individuals with developmental  
13 disabilities but who are unable to pay the legal fees  
14 associated with becoming a guardian.

15 (9) ~~(4)~~ The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All money  
16 in the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall moneys ~~to~~ be  
17 paid as grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for  
18 pediatric cancer treatment and research.

19 (10) The Knights of Columbus Fund. All money in the  
20 Knights of Columbus Fund shall be paid as grants to  
21 charitable entities designated by the Knights of Columbus.

2 Sec. 3-805. Electric vehicles.

3 (a) Until January 1, 2020, the owner of a motor vehicle of  
4 the first division or a motor vehicle of the second division  
5 weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric engine  
6 and not utilizing motor fuel, may register such vehicle for a  
7 fee not to exceed \$35 for a 2-year registration period. The  
8 Secretary may, in his discretion, prescribe that electric  
9 vehicle registration plates be issued for an indefinite term,  
10 such term to correspond to the term of registration plates  
11 issued generally, as provided in Section 3-414.1. In no event  
12 may the registration fee for electric vehicles exceed \$18 per  
13 registration year. Except as provided in subsection (b),  
14 beginning ~~Beginning~~ on January 1, 2020, the registration fee  
15 for these vehicles shall be equal to the fee set forth in  
16 Section 3-806 for motor vehicles of the first division, other  
17 than Autocycles, Motorcycles, Motor Driven Cycles, and  
18 Pedalcycles. In addition to the registration fees, the  
19 Secretary shall assess an additional \$100 per year in lieu of  
20 the payment of motor fuel taxes. \$1 of the additional fees  
21 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special  
22 Services Fund and the remainder of the additional fees shall  
23 be deposited into the Road Fund.

24 (b) The owner of a motor vehicle of the first division or a  
25 motor vehicle of the second division weighing 8,000 pounds or

1 less propelled by an electric engine and not utilizing motor  
2 fuel who qualifies for any veteran license plate offered by  
3 the Secretary shall pay the same registration fee as that  
4 charged for his or her qualifying plate.
