

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
5 changing Section 3-117.2 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-117.2) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-117.2)

7 Sec. 3-117.2. Junk Vehicle Notification. Beginning July 1,  
8 1989 a person licensed as a scrap processor or automotive  
9 parts recycler pursuant to Section 5-301 of this Code who  
10 acquires a properly assigned Certificate of Title, a Salvage  
11 Certificate, a Certificate of Purchase, or a similarly  
12 acceptable out-of-state document of ownership pursuant to  
13 Section 5-401.3 of this Code, shall within 15 days of  
14 acquiring such document, submit it to the Secretary of State  
15 along with a Junk Vehicle Notification, the form and manner  
16 for which shall be as prescribed by Secretary of State rule or  
17 regulation. A scrap processor or automotive parts recycler who  
18 acquires the above named documents of ownership pursuant to  
19 Section 5-401.3 shall not be required to apply for or obtain a  
20 junking certificate. The information contained on a Junk  
21 Vehicle Notification shall be duly recorded by the Secretary  
22 of State upon the receipt of such Notification. The Secretary  
23 of State shall not again issue a Certificate of Title or

- 1 Salvage Certificate for any vehicle listed on a Junk Vehicle
