SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

510 ILCS 70/7.1

from Ch. 8, par. 707.1

Amends the Humane Care for Animals Act. Adds firefighter and paramedic to the list of persons who are authorized, after making a reasonable effort to locate the owner or person responsible for a companion animal, to enter a motor vehicle by any reasonable means if he or she has probable cause to believe that the animal's health or safety is at risk.

1 AN ACT concerning animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by changing Section 7.1 as follows:
- 6 (510 ILCS 70/7.1) (from Ch. 8, par. 707.1)
- Sec. 7.1. Confinement in motor vehicle. No owner or 8 person shall confine any companion animal in a motor vehicle 9 in such a manner that places it in a life or health threatening situation by exposure to a prolonged period of extreme heat or 10 11 cold, without proper ventilation or other protection from such heat or cold. In order to protect the health and safety of a 12 13 companion an animal, an animal control officer, firefighter, 14 paramedic, law enforcement officer, or Department investigator who has probable cause to believe that this Section is being 15 16 violated shall have authority to enter such motor vehicle by 17 any reasonable means under the circumstances after making a reasonable effort to locate the owner or other person 18
- 20 A person convicted of violating this Section is guilty of 21 a Class C misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation is a
- 22 Class B misdemeanor.
