1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2616

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 2616 on page 7, by

3 replacing lines 13 through 26 with the following:

"(19) Acquisition of modifications or adjustments, including, but not limited to, assistive technology devices and assistive technology services, adaptive equipment, repairs, and replacement parts to provide reasonable accommodations (i) that enable a qualified applicant with a disability to complete the job application process and be considered for the position such qualified applicant desires, (ii) that modify or adjust the work environment to enable a qualified current employee with a disability to perform the essential functions of the position held by that employee, (iii) to enable a qualified current employee with a disability to enjoy equal benefits and privileges of employment as are enjoyed by its other similarly situated employees without

1 disabilities, and (iv) that allow a customer, client, claimant or member of the public seeking State services 2 3 full use and enjoyment of and access to its programs, 4 services, or benefits. 5 For purposes of this paragraph (19): "Assistive technology devices" means any item, piece 6 of equipment, or product system, whether acquired 7 commercially off the shelf, modified, or customized, that 8 9 is used to increase, maintain, or improve functional 10 capabilities of individuals with disabilities. 11 "Assistive technology services" means any service that directly assists an individual with a disability in 12 13 selection, acquisition, or use of an assistive technology 14 device. 15 "Qualified" has the same meaning and use as provided under the federal Americans with Disabilities Act when 16

describing an individual with a disability.".
