

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB2622

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 147/35

Amends the School Visitation Rights Act. Provides that an employer that terminates an employee for absences to attend school conferences is liable in a civil action for damages resulting to the employee. Imposes upon the employer the burden of proof to demonstrate that termination is not related to an employee's absence for attendance at a school conference, behavioral meeting, or academic meeting. Effective August 1, 2021.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Visitation Rights Act is amended by changing Section 35 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 35. Employee rights.
- (a) No employee shall lose any employee benefits, except 8 9 as provided for in Section 20 of this Act, for exercising his or her rights under this Act. Nothing in this Act shall be 10 construed to affect an employer's obligation to comply with 11 any collective bargaining agreement or employee benefit plan. 12 13 Nothing in this Act shall prevent an employer from providing 14 school visitation rights in excess of the requirements of this Act. The rights afforded by this Act shall not be diminished by 15 any collective bargaining act or by any employee benefit plan. 16
 - (b) An employer may not terminate an employee for an absence from work if the absence is due solely to the employee's attendance at a school conference, behavioral meeting, or academic meeting, as provided in Section 15.
- 21 <u>(c) An employer violating subsection (b) is liable in a</u>
 22 <u>civil action for damages resulting to the employee. The</u>
