A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
7 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

14 Section 10. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Asset
 16 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment
 17 of their expenditures as outlined in the Illinois Drug Asset
 18 Forfeiture Procedure Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the
 19 Controlled Substances Act, and the Environmental Safety Act.

20 Section 15. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Asset
 22 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment
 23 of their expenditures in accordance with the Federal Equitable

1 Sharing Guidelines.

2 Section 20. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
4 Police, Division of Justice Services, from the Money Laundering
5 Asset Recovery Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses
6 incurred by the Department of State Police.

7 Section 25. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the LEADS Maintenance
9 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of Justice
10 Services, for expenses related to the LEADS System.

11 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
13 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

18 Section 35. The following amount, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary for objects and purposes hereinafter named,
20 is appropriated from the Drug Traffic Prevention Fund to the
21 Department of State Police, Division of Operations, pursuant
22 to the provisions of the "Intergovernmental Drug Laws
23 Enforcement Act" for Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups.

24 For Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups:

1 Payable from the Drug Traffic
 2 Prevention Fund500,000

3 Section 40. The sum of \$18,000,000, or so much thereof as
 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
 5 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Department of
 6 State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law
 7 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State Whistleblower
 8 Protection Act.

9 Section 45. The sum of \$32,000,000, or so much thereof as
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
 11 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police
 12 for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the
 13 Department of State Police.

14 Section 50. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
 16 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police
 17 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Safe2Help
 18 Program.

19 Section 55. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police
 21 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police

1 for expenses related to officer-worn body cameras.

2 Section 60. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may
3 be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Streetgang-
4 Related Crime Fund to the Department of State Police for
5 operations related to streetgang-related crime initiatives.

6 Section 65. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Over Dimensional
8 Load Police Escort Fund to the Department of State Police for
9 expenses incurred for providing police escorts for over-
10 dimensional loads.

11 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
12 be necessary, is appropriated from the Medicaid Fraud and Abuse
13 Prevention Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of
14 Operations, for the detection, investigation or prosecution of
15 recipient or vendor fraud.

16 Section 75. The sum of \$13,000,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Law
18 Enforcement Administration Fund to the Department of State
19 Police, Division of Operations, for all costs associated with
20 a cadet program for the Department of State Police.

1 Section 80. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Scott's Law Fund to
 3 the Department of State Police for the ordinary and contingent
 4 expenses incurred by the Department of State Police.

5 Section 85. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as
 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois State
 7 Police Federal Projects Fund to the Department of State Police
 8 for current and prior year expenses relating to federal awards
 9 and grants.

10 Section 90. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 11 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 12 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

13 Section 95. The sum of \$2,250,000, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
 15 Police, Division of Forensic Services and Identification, from
 16 the Mental Health Reporting Fund for expenses as outlined in
 17 the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm Owners
 18 Identification Card Act.

19 Section 100. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
 21 Police from the State Police Firearm Services Fund for expenses
 22 as outlined in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm
 23 Owners Identification Card Act.

1 Section 105. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
3 Police, Division of Forensic Services and Identification, from
4 the Firearm Dealer License Certification Fund, for expenses as
5 outlined in the Firearm Dealer License Certification Act and
6 the Gun Trafficking Information Act.

7 Section 110. The sum of \$62,800, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
9 Police, Division of Internal Investigation, from the General
10 Revenue Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred
11 while operating the Nursing Home Identified Offender Program.

12 Section 115. The sum of \$230,000,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1
14 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of Justice
15 Services, for costs pursuant to the Emergency Telephone System
16 Act.

17 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
18 1, 2021.
