A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
8 contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice
9 Information Authority:

11 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
2 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
3 the purpose of awarding grants, contracts, administrative
4 expenses and all related costs for the Safe From the Start
5 Program.

6 Section 35. The amount of \$7,541,300, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
8 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
9 administrative costs, awards and grants for Community-Based
10 Violence Prevention Programs.

11 Section 40. The amount of \$6,094,300, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
14 grants and administrative expenses related to Metropolitan
15 Family Services' support of street intervention programming.

16 Section 45. The amount of \$6,680,000, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
19 a grant to Acclivus for violence prevention and reduction,
20 including administrative costs.

21 Section 50. The amount of \$2,200,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
2 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
3 a grant to Southland Juvenile Justice Council for violence
4 prevention and reduction, including administrative costs.

5 Section 55. The amount of \$743,200, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
8 grant to HV Neighborhood Transformation Inc. for violence
9 prevention and reduction, including administrative costs.

10 Section 60. The amount of \$743,200, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
12 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
13 grant to Chicago Area Project for violence prevention and
14 reduction, including administrative costs.

15 Section 65. The amount of \$743,200, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
17 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
18 grant to Community Lifeline for violence prevention and
19 reduction, including administrative costs.

20 Section 70. The amount of \$743,200, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

1 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
2 grant to Rockford Park District for violence prevention and
3 reduction, including administrative costs.

4 Section 75. The amount of \$743,200, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
6 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
7 grant to Peoria Park District for violence prevention and
8 reduction, including administrative costs.

9 Section 80. The amount of \$788,500, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
11 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
12 grant to Touched by an Angel Community Enrichment Center for
13 violence prevention and reduction, including administrative
14 costs.

15 Section 85. The amount of \$788,500, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
17 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
18 grant to Proviso Leyden Community Council for Community Action
19 for violence prevention and reduction, including administrative
20 costs.

21 Section 90. The amount of \$788,500, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
2 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
3 grant to H.O.P.E. Helping Our People Excel for violence
4 prevention and reduction, including administrative costs.

5 Section 95. The amount of \$788,500, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
8 grant to City of Chicago for violence prevention and reduction
9 in West Humboldt Park, East Garfield Park, West Garfield Park
10 and Near West, including administrative costs.

11 Section 100. The amount of \$800,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
13 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for a
14 grant to the East St. Louis School District #189 for trauma
15 recovery services, including administrative costs.

16 Section 105. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
19 a grant to the Safer Foundation for violence prevention
20 services and any associated administrative expenses.

21 Section 110. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 2 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
 3 grants to local law enforcement agencies for training pursuant
 4 to the Community-Law Enforcement Partnership for Deflection and
 5 Addiction Treatment Act and any associated administrative
 6 expenses.

7 Section 115. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof
 8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 9 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
 10 costs associated with implementation of House Bill 3653 of the
 11 101st General Assembly, if enacted.

12 ARTICLE 2

13 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 14 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
 15 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and contingent
 16 expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
 17 Authority:

10 Section 10. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICJIA Violence
 12 Prevention Special Projects Fund to the Illinois Criminal
 13 Justice Information Authority for administrative costs, awards
 14 and grants for Adult Redeploy and Diversion Programs.

15 Section 15. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
 17 Information Projects Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 18 Information Authority for distribution to fund Department of
 19 State Police drug task forces and Metropolitan Enforcement
 20 Groups.

21 Section 20. The amount of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof
 22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice

1 Information Projects Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 2 Information Authority for distribution of revenue pursuant to
 3 Section 21.10 of the Illinois Lottery Law.

4 Section 25. The amount of \$45,000,000, or so much thereof
 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
 6 Information Projects Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 7 Information Authority for administrative costs, awards and
 8 grants associated with the Restore, Reinvest, and Renew
 9 Program.

10 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 11 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
 12 Justice Information Authority for awards and grants and other
 13 monies received from federal agencies, from other units of
 14 government, and from private/not-for-profit organizations for
 15 activities undertaken in support of investigating issues in
 16 criminal justice and for undertaking other criminal justice
 17 information projects:

1 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
 3 Justice Information Authority for activities undertaken in
 4 support of federal assistance programs administered by units
 5 of state and local government and non-profit organizations:

6 Payable from the Criminal Justice
 7 Trust Fund7,000,000

8 Section 40. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof
 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
 10 Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
 11 Authority for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

12 Section 45. The amount of \$140,000,000, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
 14 Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
 15 Authority for awards and grants to local units of government,
 16 state agencies and non-profit organizations.

17 Section 50. The amount of \$7,800, or so much thereof as
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois State Crime
 19 Stoppers Association Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 20 Information Authority for grants to enhance and develop Crime
 21 Stoppers programs in Illinois.

1 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
 3 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
 4 Justice Information Authority for the training of law
 5 enforcement personnel and services for families of victims of
 6 homicide or murder:

17 Section 60. The amount of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Prescription Pill
 19 and Drug Disposal Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 20 Information Authority for the purpose of collection,
 21 transportation, and incineration of pharmaceuticals by local
 22 law enforcement agencies.

23 Section 65. The amount of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
2 Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
3 Authority for administrative costs, awards and grants
4 associated with the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding
5 (CESF) Program

6 ARTICLE 99

7 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
8 2021.
