1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The amount of \$2,424,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

Section 10. The sum of \$381,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses associated with the administration and enforcement associated with the P-20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.

Section 15. The sum of \$183,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated with the My Credits Transfer System.

Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

- 11 distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying Higher
- 12 Education Faculty in Illinois Program.
- 13 Section 50. The sum of \$373,900, or so much thereof as may
- 14 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 15 the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants for
- 16 nursing schools to increase the number of graduating nurses.
- 17 Section 55. The sum of \$197,400, or so much thereof as may
- 18 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 19 the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator fellowships
- 20 to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

- 1 Section 60. The sum of \$980,500, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 3 the Board of Higher Education for distribution as grants for
- 4 Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of higher
- 5 education.
- 6 Section 65. The sum of \$1,055,700, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 8 to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the Board of
- 9 Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for the
- 10 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.
- 11 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000 or so much thereof as may
- be necessary, is appropriated from the Distance Learning Fund
- 13 to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for
- 14 costs and expenses associated with the administration and
- enforcement of 110 ILCS 145/40.
- Section 75. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality
- 18 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental
- 19 support for costs and expenses associated with the
- administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.
- 21 Section 80. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as

- 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College
- 2 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher
- 3 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses
- 4 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS
- 5 1005.
- 6 Section 85. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Data and Research
- 8 Cost Recovery Fund to the Board of Higher Education as
- 9 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with the
- 10 administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 205.
- 11 Section 90. The amount of \$650,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business and
- 13 Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of
- 14 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses
- 15 associated with the administration and enforcement of the
- 16 Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.
- 17 Section 95. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants
- 19 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under the
- 20 terms and conditions associated with the federal contracts and
- 21 grants moneys received.

1	Section 100. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
2	maybe necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
3	to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses
4	associated with the implementation of the new strategic plan.

- Section. 105. The sum of \$43,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants Fund to the Board of Higher Education for grants, contracts, and administrative expenses of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund award.
