- 4 The court may apportion the costs of counseling 5 between the parties as appropriate.
- 6 (c) The remedies provided in this Section are in addition to, and do not diminish or abridge in any way, the court's 7 power to exercise its authority through contempt or other 8
- 10 (d) Counseling ordered under this Section is subject to 11 the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Confidentiality Act and the federal Health Insurance 12 13 Portability and Accountability Act of 1996. All counseling sessions shall be confidential. The communications 14 15 counseling shall not be used in any manner in litigation nor 16 relied upon by any expert appointed by the court or retained by 17 any party.
