

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB2832

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-43 new

Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that in order to recover an overpayment by recoupment or offset of future payments, a managed care organization's post-payment audit of any claim submitted by a provider must be completed no later than 2 years after the claim's payment date. Provides that the 2-year time limit does not apply to claims that are (i) submitted fraudulently, (ii) known, or should have been known, by the provider to be a pattern of inappropriate billing according to standard provider billing practices, or (iii) subject to any federal law or regulation that permits post-payment audits beyond 2 years.

1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-43 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-43 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-43. MCO post-payment audit; time period limitation. Notwithstanding any provision of this Code to the contrary, in 8 9 order to recover an overpayment by recoupment or offset of 10 future payments, a managed care organization's post-payment audit of any claim submitted by a provider must be completed no 11 later than 2 years after the claim's payment date. The 2-year 12 time limit does not apply to claims that are (i) submitted 13 14 fraudulently, (ii) known, or should have been known, by the provider to be a pattern of inappropriate billing according to 15 standard provider billing practices, or (iii) subject to any 16 federal law or regulation that permits post-payment audits 17 beyond 2 years. 18
