5 ILCS 490/194 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Provides that August 26 of each year is designated as Illinois Constitution Day, to be observed throughout the State as a day to commemorate August 26, 1818 as the day Illinois ratified its first State Constitution.

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
5 adding Section 194 as follows:

7 Sec. 194. Illinois Constitution Day. August 26 of each
8 year is designated as Illinois Constitution Day, to be
9 observed throughout the State as a day to commemorate August
10 26, 1818 as the day Illinois ratified its first State
11 Constitution.
