Section 5. The Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems
Act is amended by adding Section 3.89 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 3.89. Rural populations; credential exception.</u>

(a) In a rural population of 5,000 or fewer inhabitants, 8 9 each EMS System Medical Director may create an exception to the credentialing process to allow registered nurses, 10 physician assistants, and advanced practice registered nurses 11 12 to apply to serve as volunteers who perform the same work as EMTs. As part of the volunteer recognition process, EMS 13 14 Systems shall ensure that registered nurses, physician assistants, and advanced practice registered nurses have an 15 active license issued by the Department of Financial and 16 Professional Regulation. This system-level recognition shall 17 require documentation and proof of the completion of at least 18 20 hours of prehospital care-specific coursework approved by 19 the Department of Public Health, including, but not limited 20 21 to, airway management, ambulance operation, ambulance 22 equipment, extrication, telecommunication, prehospital cardiac and trauma care, and 8 hours of observant riding time. 23

2	the credentialing process under this Section may require
