

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB2868

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-1-15 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that, in a police department in a municipality with a population over 1,000,000 inhabitants, police officers assigned to one of the 5 precincts with the fewest officers assigned may not be transferred or reassigned to another precinct, including temporary reassignments, unless an equal or greater number of police officers are transferred or assigned to the precinct from which the officer was transferred or reassigned to replace the leaving officer. Limits home rule powers. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding Section 11-1-15 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-1-15 new)
- 7 Sec. 11-1-15. Transfers between precincts. In a police department in a municipality with a population over 1,000,000 8 9 inhabitants, police officers assigned to one of the 5 precincts with the fewest officers assigned may not be 10 transferred or reassigned to another precinct, including 11 12 temporary reassignments, unless an equal or greater number of police officers are transferred or assigned to the precinct 13 14 from which the officer was transferred or reassigned to replace the leaving officer. 15
- A home rule municipality with a population over 1,000,000

 inhabitants may not regulate transfers or assignments in

 police departments in a manner inconsistent with this Section.

 This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6

 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent

 exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised

 by the State.
