### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 605/605-1047

Amends the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Modifies the definition of "Local government" or "unit of local government" to include a public safety answering point, 9-1-1 network, 9-1-1 system, or 9-1-1 authority, and any other type of local public safety entity deemed appropriate by the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, for the purpose of receiving funds under the Local Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency (Local CURE) Support Program.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Economic  
5 Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois  
6 is amended by renumbering and changing Section 605-1045 as  
7 follows:

8 (20 ILCS 605/605-1047)

9 Sec. 605-1047 ~~605-1045~~. Local Coronavirus Urgent  
10 Remediation Emergency (or Local CURE) Support Program.

11 (a) Purpose. The Department may receive, directly or  
12 indirectly, federal funds from the Coronavirus Relief Fund  
13 provided to the State pursuant to Section 5001 of the federal  
14 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to  
15 provide financial support to units of local government for  
16 purposes authorized by Section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus  
17 Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and related  
18 federal guidance. Upon receipt of such funds, and  
19 appropriations for their use, the Department shall administer  
20 a Local Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency (or Local  
21 CURE) Support Program to provide financial support to units of  
22 local government that have incurred necessary expenditures due  
23 to the COVID-19 public health emergency. The Department shall

1 provide by rule the administrative framework for the Local  
2 CURE Support Program.

3 (b) Allocations. A portion of the funds appropriated for  
4 the Local CURE Support Program may be allotted to  
5 municipalities and counties based on proportionate population.  
6 Units of local government, or portions thereof, located within  
7 the five Illinois counties that received direct allotments  
8 from the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund will not be included  
9 in the support program allotments. The Department may  
10 establish other administrative procedures for providing  
11 financial support to units of local government. Appropriated  
12 funds may be used for administration of the support program,  
13 including the hiring of a service provider to assist with  
14 coordination and administration.

15 (c) Administrative Procedures. The Department may  
16 establish administrative procedures for the support program,  
17 including any application procedures, grant agreements,  
18 certifications, payment methodologies, and other  
19 accountability measures that may be imposed upon recipients of  
20 funds under the grant program. Financial support may be  
21 provided in the form of grants or in the form of expense  
22 reimbursements for disaster-related expenditures. The  
23 emergency rulemaking process may be used to promulgate the  
24 initial rules of the grant program.

25 (d) Definitions. As used in this Section:

26 (1) "COVID-19" means the novel coronavirus virus

1 disease deemed COVID-19 by the World Health Organization  
2 on February 11, 2020.

3 (2) "Local government" or "unit of local government"  
4 means any unit of local government as defined in Article  
5 VII, Section 1 of the Illinois Constitution, and includes  
6 a public safety answering point, 9-1-1 network, 9-1-1  
7 system, or 9-1-1 authority as defined by section 2 of the  
8 Emergency Telephone System Act, or any other type of local  
9 public safety entity deemed appropriate by the Department.

10 (3) "Third party administrator" means a service  
11 provider selected by the Department to provide operational  
12 assistance with the administration of the support program.

13 (e) Powers of the Department. The Department has the power  
14 to:

15 (1) Provide financial support to eligible units of  
16 local government with funds appropriated from the Local  
17 Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency (Local CURE) Fund  
18 to cover necessary costs incurred due to the COVID-19  
19 public health emergency that are eligible to be paid using  
20 federal funds from the Coronavirus Relief Fund.

21 (2) Enter into agreements, accept funds, issue grants  
22 or expense reimbursements, and engage in cooperation with  
23 agencies of the federal government and units of local  
24 governments to carry out the purposes of this support  
25 program, and to use funds appropriated from the Local  
26 Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency (Local CURE) Fund

1 fund upon such terms and conditions as may be established  
2 by the federal government and the Department.

3 (3) Enter into agreements with third-party  
4 administrators to assist the state with operational  
5 assistance and administrative functions related to review  
6 of documentation and processing of financial support  
7 payments to units of local government.

8 (4) Establish applications, notifications, contracts,  
9 and procedures and adopt rules deemed necessary and  
10 appropriate to carry out the provisions of this Section.  
11 To provide for the expeditious and timely implementation  
12 of this Act, emergency rules to implement any provision of  
13 this Section may be adopted by the Department subject to  
14 the provisions of Section 5-45 of the Illinois  
15 Administrative Procedure Act.

16 (5) Provide staff, administration, and related support  
17 required to manage the support program and pay for the  
18 staffing, administration, and related support with funds  
19 appropriated from the Local Coronavirus Urgent Remediation  
20 Emergency (Local CURE) Fund.

21 (6) Exercise such other powers as are necessary or  
22 incidental to the foregoing.

23 (f) Local CURE Financial Support to Local Governments. The  
24 Department is authorized to provide financial support to  
25 eligible units of local government including, but not limited  
26 to, certified local health departments for necessary costs

1 incurred due to the COVID-19 public health emergency that are  
2 eligible to be paid using federal funds from the Coronavirus  
3 Relief Fund.

4 (1) Financial support funds may be used by a unit of  
5 local government only for payment of costs that: (i) are  
6 necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health  
7 emergency of COVID-19; (ii) were not accounted for in the  
8 most recent budget approved as of March 27, 2020 for the  
9 unit of local government; and (iii) were incurred between  
10 March 1, 2020 and December 30, 2020.

11 (2) A unit of local government receiving financial  
12 support funds under this program shall certify to the  
13 Department that it shall use the funds in accordance with  
14 the requirements of paragraph (1) and that any funds  
15 received but not used for such purposes shall be repaid to  
16 the Department.

17 (3) The Department shall make the determination to  
18 provide financial support funds to a unit of local  
19 government on the basis of criteria established by the  
20 Department.
