1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by adding Section 22.62 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/22.62 new)
- 7 Sec. 22.62. PFAS; incineration.
- 8 (a) In this Section:
- 9 "Incineration" includes, but is not limited to, burning,
- 10 <u>combustion</u>, <u>pyrolysis</u>, <u>gasification</u>, <u>thermal oxidation</u>,
- including flameless and regenerative, or the use of an acid
- 12 <u>recovery furnace or oxidizer, ore roaster, cement kiln,</u>
- 13 <u>lightweight aggregate kiln, industrial furnace, boiler, or</u>
- 14 process heater.
- "Perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances" or "PFAS"
- 16 means a class of fluorinated organic chemicals containing at
- 17 <u>least one fully fluorinated carbon atom.</u>
- 18 (b) The disposal by incineration of any perfluoroalkyl and
- 19 polyfluoroalkyl substance, including, but not limited to,
- 20 aqueous film forming foam, is prohibited in Illinois. The
- 21 Agency may adopt any rules or regulations it deems necessary
- in order to carry out the provisions of this Section.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 1
