

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB3320

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 5/232 new

Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Provides that the owner of a pollinator-friendly solar site is entitled to an income tax credit in the amount of \$250 per taxable year.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by adding Section 232 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 5/232 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 232. Pollinator-friendly solar site credit.</u>
- 8 (a) For taxable years ending on or after December 31,
  9 2021, the owner of a pollinator-friendly solar site designated
- 10 <u>under the Pollinator-Friendly Solar Site Act is entitled to a</u>
- credit against the tax imposed by subsections (a) and (b) of
- 12 <u>Section 201 in the amount of \$250 per taxable year.</u>
- 13 (b) The credit or credits may not reduce the taxpayer's
- 14 <u>liability to less than zero. If the amount of the credit or</u>
- credits exceeds the taxpayer's liability, the excess may be
- 16 <u>carried forward and applied against the taxpayer's liability</u>
- for the next 5 succeeding calendar years. The credit or
- credits shall be applied to the earliest year for which there
- is a tax liability. If there are credits from more than one
- 20 <u>taxable year that are available to offset a liability, the</u>
- 21 <u>earlier credit shall be applied first.</u>
- (c) This Section is exempt from the provisions of Section
- 23 <u>250.</u>
