SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Polygraph Exam Integrity Act. Provides that every polygraph question submitted for the administration of a polygraph exam by a State agency or entity shall be screened by independent legal counsel to ensure compliance with the Illinois Constitution and the United States Constitution and federal and State law. Provides that screenings shall be paid by the entity requesting the service.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Polygraph Exam Integrity Act.

6 Section 5. Polygraph questions. Notwithstanding any
7 provision of law to the contrary, every polygraph question
8 submitted for the administration of a polygraph exam for
9 hiring by a State agency or entity shall be screened by legal
10 counsel to ensure compliance with the Illinois and the
11 Constitution of the United States and federal and State law.
12 Screenings shall be paid by the entity requesting the service.
