SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 430/25-105

Amends the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act. Provides that the Legislative Inspector General may investigate any allegation or complaint under his or her jurisdiction (currently, allegations or complaints of sexual harassment) without the approval of the Legislative Ethics Commission. Makes conforming changes.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Officials and Employees Ethics Act is
5 amended by changing Section 25-105 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 430/25-105)

7 Sec. 25-105. Opening investigations ~~Investigation of~~
8 ~~sexual harassment~~. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
9 contrary, the Legislative Inspector General may investigate
10 any allegation or complaint under his or her jurisdiction ~~of~~
11 ~~sexual harassment~~ without the approval of the Legislative
12 Ethics Commission. At each Legislative Ethics Commission
13 meeting, the Legislative Inspector General shall inform the
14 Commission of each investigation opened under this Section
15 since the last meeting of the Commission.
