

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB3641

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Social Media Platforms Liability for Incitement of Violence Act. Provides that a social media platform having actual knowledge of a post on its platform that causes an incitement of violence shall remove the post within 24 hours. Provides that failure by a social media platform to remove the post within 24 hours shall result in a civil penalty of \$10,000 per violation. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Social
- 5 Media Platforms Liability for Incitement of Violence Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- 7 "Incitement of violence" means speech that creates an
- 8 immediate risk of harm to a specific person or persons or to
- 9 property.
- "Post" means any information or data submitted by a third
- 11 party to a social media platform that is capable of then being
- displayed using the software or approved hardware.
- "Social media platform" means an electronic medium where
- 14 users may create and view user-generated content, such as
- 15 uploaded or downloaded videos or still photographs, blogs,
- video blogs, podcasts, or instant messages.
- 17 Section 10. Prohibitions. A social media platform having
- 18 actual knowledge of a post on its platform that causes an
- 19 incitement of violence shall remove the post within 24 hours.
- 20 Section 15. Penalties. Failure by a social media platform
- 21 to comply with the provisions of Section 10 shall result in a

- 1 civil penalty of \$10,000 per violation.
- 2 Section 97. Severability. If any provision of this Act or
- 3 its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid,
- 4 the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 5 applications of this Act which can be given effect without the
- 6 invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this Act
- 7 are severable.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.
