SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1370/1-65 new

Amends the Department of Innovation and Technology Act. Requires the Department of Innovation and Technology to work to ensure the security of the social media and Internet presence of State elected officials and State agencies and, to the extent possible, reserve the use of State government online accounts, whether social media or email, for use only by State officials, State agencies, and employees thereof, to prevent false personation. Provides for the adoption of rules. Defines "false personation".

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of Innovation and Technology Act
5 is amended by adding Section 1-65 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 1370/1-65 new)

7 Sec. 1-65. State government Internet credentials; false
8 personation. As soon as practicable after the effective date
9 of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly, the
10 Department shall work to ensure the security of the social
11 media and Internet presence of State elected officials and
12 State agencies, and shall, to the extent possible, reserve the
13 use of State government online accounts, whether social media
14 or email, for use only by State officials, State agencies, and
15 employees thereof, to prevent false personation. The
16 Department shall adopt all rules necessary for the
17 implementation of this Section. For the purposes of this
18 Section, "false personation" has the same meaning as provided
19 under Section 17-2 of the Criminal Code of 2012.
