SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

725 ILCS 150/5

from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 1675

Amends the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act. Deletes provision that when the property seized for forfeiture is a vehicle, the law enforcement agency seizing the property shall immediately notify the Secretary of State that forfeiture proceedings are pending regarding the vehicle.

AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act is 5 amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 150/5) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 1675)

7 Sec. 5. Notice to State's Attorney. The law enforcement 8 agency seizing property for forfeiture under the Illinois 9 Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, or the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, or the 10 Illinois Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act shall, as soon as 11 practicable but not later than 28 days after the seizure, 12 notify the State's Attorney for the county in which an act or 13 14 omission giving rise to the seizure occurred or in which the property was seized of the seizure of the property and the 15 facts and circumstances giving rise to the seizure and shall 16 17 provide the State's Attorney with the inventory of the property and its estimated value. Said notice shall be by the 18 19 delivery of Form 4-64. When the property seized for forfeiture 20 is a vehicle, the law enforcement agency seizing the property 21 shall immediately notify the Secretary of State that 22 forfeiture proceedings are pending regarding such vehicle.
