#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

725 ILCS 5/103-2.2 new

Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Provides that, notwithstanding any other provision of law, law enforcement interrogations are limited to a maximum of 9 hours in a 24 hour time frame.

4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is

7 Sec. 103-2.2. Interrogation length. Notwithstanding any  
8 other provision of law, law enforcement interrogations are  
9 limited to a maximum of 9 hours in a 24 hour time frame.
