### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

765 ILCS 835/14.6 new

Amends the Cemetery Protection Act. Requires a court order before a cemetery may disinter deceased human remains from a multiple-depth burial plot if the involved decedent is not located within a concrete outer burial container and if the involved decedent was interred 10 or more years ago.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Cemetery Protection Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 14.6 as follows:

6 (765 ILCS 835/14.6 new)

7 Sec. 14.6. Disinterment of deceased human remains from  
8 multiple depth burial plots. To help safeguard against the  
9 unnecessary disruption of other deceased human remains, and in  
10 recognition of the difficulty in identifying human remains  
11 after the decomposition process has progressed over time, a  
12 court order shall be required before a cemetery may disinter  
13 deceased human remains from a multiple-depth burial plot if  
14 the involved decedent is not located within a concrete outer  
15 burial container and if the involved decedent was interred 10  
16 or more years ago.
