## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/3.1-55-30 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a municipality may not prohibit a speaker at a public meeting from addressing an individual member of the city council, a municipal official, or a staff member of these individuals, except that these provisions do not prohibit a municipality from limiting when a speaker may speak at a meeting. Limits home rule powers. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 5 adding Section 3.1-55-30 as follows:

Sec. 3.1-55-30. Addressing city council members at public
meetings.

9 <u>(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a</u> 10 <u>municipality may not prohibit a speaker at a public meeting</u> 11 <u>from addressing an individual member of the city council, a</u> 12 <u>municipal official, or a staff member of these individuals.</u> 13 <u>This subsection does not prohibit a municipality from limiting</u> 14 when a speaker may speak at a meeting.

15 <u>(b) A home rule municipality may not regulate addressing</u> 16 <u>individual city council members, municipal officials, or staff</u> 17 <u>members of these individuals at a city council meeting in a</u> 18 <u>manner inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a</u> 19 <u>limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of</u> 20 <u>the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home</u> 21 rule units of powers and functions exercised by the State.
