Appropriates specified amounts from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for specified purposes. Effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those  
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
6 purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
7 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of  
8 the State Appellate Defender.

10	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	1,482,890
11	For Contractual Services .....	3,019,520

19 Section 10. The amount of \$184,551, or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
21 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary  
22 and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

1           Section 15. The amount \$100,000, or so much thereof as may  
2           be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
3           the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide  
4           training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training  
5           Program.

6           Section 20. The amount of \$608,286, or so much thereof as  
7           may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund to  
8           the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile  
9           Defender Resource Center.

10           Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
11           2021.
