Makes appropriations to the State Board of Education from various funds for evidence-based funding under the School Code. Effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those
5 amounts as may be necessary, are appropriated to the State
6 Board of Education for evidence-based funding under Section 18-
7 8.15 of the School Code:

8	Payable from the Education Assistance Fund	\$328,529,000
9	Payable from the Common School Fund	\$3,029,136,300
10	Payable from the General Revenue Fund	\$3,431,372,927
11	Payable from the Fund for the Advancement of	
12	Education	\$790,000,000

13 It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide
14 sufficient appropriations in this Section to ensure that the
15 base funding minimum and the minimum funding level provided for
16 in the evidence-based funding requirements under Public Act
17 100-465 are met for Fiscal Year 2022.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2021.
