SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Vaccine Credential Act. Provides that a unit of local government or the State may not require a person to have a vaccine credential or show a vaccine credential before the person enters a public event or public venue. Limits home rule powers. Defines "vaccine credential" as any written or electronic record evidencing that a person has received a vaccine. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning vaccines.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Vaccine Credential Act.

6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act, "vaccine
7 credential" means any written or electronic record evidencing
8 that a person has received a vaccine.

9 Section 10. Vaccine credentials for public events or
10 venues. A unit of local government or the State may not require
11 a person to have a vaccine credential or show a vaccine
12 credential before the person enters a public event or public
13 venue.

14 Section 15. Home rule. A home rule unit may not regulate
15 vaccine credentials in a manner inconsistent with this Act.
16 This Act is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of
17 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent
18 exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised
19 by the State.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon

1 becoming law.
