SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 5/3.3 new

Amends the General Assembly Organization Act. Provides that neither house of the General Assembly shall consider or take a vote on any legislation between the hours of 12:00 AM to 6:00 AM, on any day of the week and during any regular or special session of the General Assembly, unless approved by the leaders of each respective caucus of the House of Representatives or the Senate. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The General Assembly Organization Act is
5 amended by adding Section 3.3 as follows:

6 (25 ILCS 5/3.3 new)

7 Sec. 3.3. Midnight legislation prohibition.
8 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
9 beginning on and after the effective date of this amendatory
10 Act of the 102nd General Assembly, neither house of the
11 General Assembly shall consider or take a vote on any
12 legislation between the hours of 12:00 AM to 6:00 AM, on any
13 day of the week and during any regular or special session of
14 the General Assembly, unless approved by the leaders of each
15 respective caucus of the House of Representatives or the
16 Senate.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
18 becoming law.
