AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4243

AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4243 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

"Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 10-20.9a as follows:

(105 ILCS 5/10-20.9a) (from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.9a)
Sec. 10-20.9a. Final grade; promotion.

(a) Teachers shall administer the approved marking system or other approved means of evaluating pupil progress. The teacher shall maintain the responsibility and right to determine grades and other evaluations of students within the grading policies of the district based upon his or her professional judgment of available criteria pertinent to any given subject area or activity for which he or she is responsible. District policy shall provide the procedure and reasons by and for which a grade may be changed; provided that

no grade or evaluation shall be changed without notification to the teacher concerning the nature and reasons for such change. If such a change is made, the person making the change shall assume such responsibility for determining the grade or

evaluation, and shall initial such change.

- (b) School districts shall not promote students to the 6 next higher grade level based upon age or any other social 7 reasons not related to the academic performance of the 8 students. On or before September 1, 1998, school boards shall 9 10 adopt and enforce a policy on promotion as they deem necessary 11 to ensure that students meet local goals and objectives and can perform at the expected grade level prior to promotion. 12 13 Decisions to promote or retain students in any classes shall 14 based on successful completion of the curriculum, 15 attendance, performance based on the assessments required 16 under Section 2-3.64a-5 of this Code, the Iowa Test of Basic Skills, or other testing or any other criteria established by 17 18 the school board. Students determined by the local district to not qualify for promotion to the next higher grade shall be 19 20 provided remedial assistance, which may include, but shall not 2.1 be limited to, a summer bridge program of no less than 90 22 tutorial sessions, increased or concentrated 23 instructional time, modifications to instructional materials, 24 and retention in grade.
  - (c) No public high school of a school district shall withhold a student's grades, transcripts, or diploma because

- 1 of an unpaid balance on the student's school account.
