SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 535/17 new

Amends the Architectural, Engineering, and Land Surveying Qualifications Based Selection Act. Provides that in the procurement of architectural, engineering, and land surveying services and in the awarding of contracts for such services under the Act, not less than 30% of the total dollar amount of State contracts shall be established as an aspirational goal to be awarded to firms owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities. Provides that of that total amount of all State contracts awarded to firms owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities, contracts representing at least 16% shall be awarded to firms owned by minorities, contracts representing at least 10% shall be awarded to women-owned firms, and contracts representing at least 4% shall be awarded to firms owned by persons with disabilities.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Architectural, Engineering, and Land
5 Surveying Qualifications Based Selection Act is amended by
6 adding Section 17 as follows:

8 Sec. 17. Contract goals. Notwithstanding any provision of
9 law to the contrary, in the procurement of architectural,
10 engineering, and land surveying services and in the awarding
11 of contracts for such services under this Act, not less than
12 30% of the total dollar amount of State contracts shall be
13 established as an aspirational goal to be awarded to firms
14 owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities. Of
15 that total amount of all State contracts awarded to firms
16 owned by minorities, women, and persons with disabilities
17 under this Section, contracts representing at least 16% shall
18 be awarded to firms owned by minorities, contracts
19 representing at least 10% shall be awarded to women-owned
20 firms, and contracts representing at least 4% shall be awarded
21 to firms owned by persons with disabilities.
