1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
6 to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for grants to not-
7 for-profit organizations for security improvements that assist
8 the organization in preventing, preparing for, or responding
9 to acts of terrorism as provided under subsection (g-5) of
10 Section 5 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act.
