1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The amount of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for grants to notfor-profit organizations for security improvements that assist
the organization in preventing, preparing for, or responding
to acts of terrorism as provided under subsection (g-5) of
Section 5 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act.
