1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4696 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4696 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources Act is 4 5 amended by changing Section 1-17 as follows: 6 (20 ILCS 801/1-17) 7 Sec. 1-17. Licenses; privacy protection. 8 (a) For purposes of this Section, "license" means a license required under Article 3 of the Wildlife Code or under 9 10 Article 20 of the Fish and Aquatic Life Code. (b) As soon as practicable, the Department must assign a 11 12 customer identification number to each applicant for a license. After the applicant has been assigned a customer 13

identification number, the applicant may use that customer

identification number in place of his or her social security

number on any subsequent application for a license.

- 1 Department must keep a record of the social security number of
- 2 each applicant. The Department shall notify the applicant that
- his or her social security number is kept on file with the 3
- 4 Department.

- 5 (c) A licensee's social security number shall not appear

- on the face of his or her license. (d) The Department shall offer to each applicant for a 7 hunting license issued under the Wildlife Code the opportunity 8 9 to have his or her name included in the First Person Consent 10 organ and tissue donor registry maintained by the Secretary of

- 25 that agree to be included in the First Person Consent organ and
- tissue donor registry and provide the information to the 26

- Secretary of State for notation of the agreement in the First 1
- Person Consent organ and tissue donor registry. A hunting 2
- 3 license issued under the Wildlife Code may contain information
- 4 indicating whether the holder of the license is registered as
- 5 a donor in the First Person Consent organ and tissue donor
- 6 registry.
